Chicory/Endive

Collards – direct and as transplants

Corn Salad - direct

Kale - direct

Leeks (indoors or pre-germinated)

Lettuce – direct of as transplants

Mustards – direct seeding

Onions – seed/transplants/sets

Parsley – direct

Parsnips - direct

Peas - direct

Potatoes – early varieties

Radish - direct

Rutabaga - direct

Shallots - direct

Spinach – winter varieties

Tomatoes – indoors for seedlings only

Turnips – direct
