1. Send your letter to each *city councilor*, the *mayor* and *the city manager*
2. Submit a copy of letter to *James White* (***to be included in the councilors' packets for the public hearing.***)
3. Include Ccs to:  
*Chuck McMahan*, County Community Development Director  
*Brian Haines*, County Manager  
*Oscar Butler*, Count Commissioner
4. Collect copies of all letters for eventual hand delivery to the *appropriate* reviewing depts. (the reviewing depts. will be represented in the "packet" NVNA is trying to get.") This ensures more contacts! A partial list:
